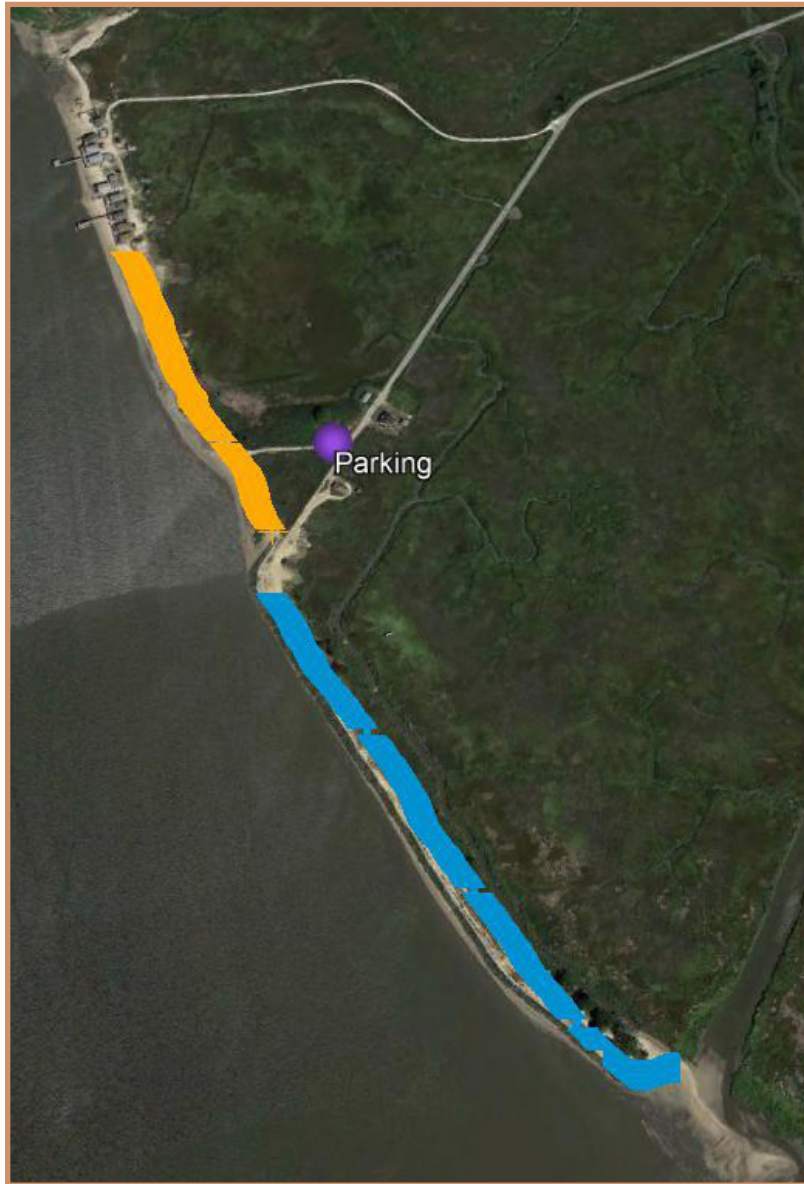

## Beach Information

Total Distance – 0.88 km

- Section 1 - 0.30 km:** Starting from the parking area and heading north, this section of beach this area has had rubble but there was a cleanup in 2019 that has helped reduce the crabs trapped here. As you head north towards the houses, there will be a sign marking private property, be sure to walk below the high tide line after this point.
- Section 2 - 0.58 km:** This part of the beach was formerly a sea wall. Most of the original sea wall has been removed. There is severe erosion and small rubble on the beach. There is still some portions of the sea wall on the southernmost portion of this beach, near the creek. The road is now completed gone.

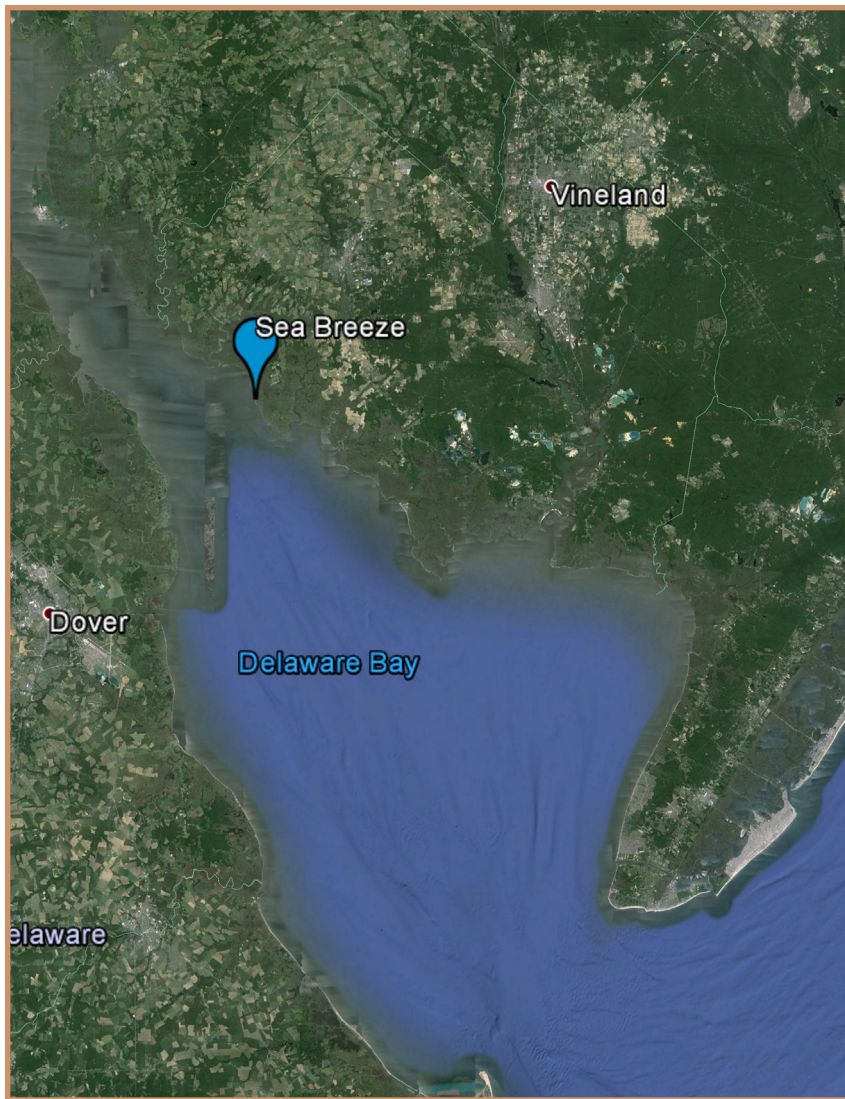

## Directions:

**From Millville:** Starting on W Main St/Rt-49, turn left onto Beech St and Continue onto Fairton Rd. Continue onto Fairton Millville Rd/Rt-698. After about 8.5 miles, Fairton Millville Rd becomes Main St. After 0.3 miles, turn right onto Back Neck Rd.

**From Bridgeton:** Begin on Grove St heading south. Continue onto Bridgeton Fairton Rd for 1.6 mil. Turn right onto Main St. After only 0.3 miles, turn right onto Back Neck Rd.

**From the South:** From NJ-47 N or NJ-347N, turn left onto Mauricetown Crossway Rd. After 1.6 miles turn right onto E Buckshutem Rd. Travel 11 miles to turn left onto Fairton Millville Rd. After about 4.2 miles, Fairton Millville Rd becomes Main St. After 0.3 miles, turn right onto Back Neck Rd.

**Once on Back Neck Rd:** Drive 4.9 miles on Back Neck Rd. Make the slight left onto Seabreeze Rd. Turn left to stay on Seabreeze Rd. When the road reaches the Bay there will be parking along the side of the road.

During high tide or extreme storms the road will sometimes flood, be cautious of high water or pool of water on the road.
